## Lewiston 2011 – 2013 TIP Request

The Lewis Clark Valley MPO has developed the 2011-2013 Transportation Improvement Program for the Idaho portion of the MPO. This is the public's opportunity to comment on the proposed funding for the City of Lewiston federal program of projects, including transit funding. Comments are encouraged and may be e-mailed to [swatson@cityoflewiston.org](mailto:swatson@cityoflewiston.org) by Thursday, June 3, 2010.

Lewiston receives approximately \$410,000 annually in Federal Transit Administration Section 5307 funds for operation of the Lewiston Transit System. The City proposes to utilize these funds in the following manner (federal funds only are shown):

FY 11 Operating \$319,000 - Capital Projects \$91,000

FY 12 Operating \$345,000 - Capital Projects \$65,000

FY 13 Operating \$356,000 - Capital Projects \$54,000

These funds require a local match. Operating funds require a 50% local match; complementary para-transit "dial a ride" requires a 20% local match. Capital projects require a 20% local match.
